

# Mystery Party:

## Escape Room Clues

- 1) **Verbally given to them** – “Listen closely to the first clue. Go where you might use the color blue.”
  - 2) **Hidden where you’ve staged some art supplies** – This clue they will discover by using a blue marker to color over a message you’ve written with white crayon on a white piece of paper. – Look high. Look low. Look where you can see the wind blow.
  - 3) **Taped on a window** – This clue they will have to discover by using their decoding ring. – Don’t squint. Don’t squirm. Use the mirror to learn the words.
  - 4) **Hidden behind a mirror** – This clue you will have written backwards and they will have to hold it up in front of a mirror to read. – If you’re tired take a seat, but do not snooze or you’ll be late.
  - 5) **Hidden under a chair/bean bag/bed** – Write the message on a piece of paper. Crumple it up a few times to get it good and wrinkly and then tear the message into as many pieces as you feel is appropriate. Then hide them. – Puzzle, puzzle what to do. Piece by piece a mystery clue. Put together and you will find, a clue to get you out of this bind.
  - 6) **Hidden on puzzles** – Get one or more simple children’s puzzles. Put them together and flip them over so the blank side is up. Write the next clue on a piece of paper. Cut out each word and tape each word on a separate puzzle piece. Flip the puzzles back over and break them apart. – Open the box and you will see the answer you need: the mystery key!
